

TWHS students took the STAAR EOC (State of Texas Assessment of Academic Readiness End Of Course) assessments for Algebra 1, Biology, English 1, English 2 and US History during the spring of this school year. High school graduation is dependent upon a passing score on all five of these tests. We strongly encourage all students to retest this summer if they did not meet the passing standard. We would also suggest they take advantage of the free boot camp offered at the TWHS 9th grade campus to help prepare them to take the exam. Details about boot camp and summer testing are listed below. **Please note, due to the hiring of staff and use of building facilities we need an accurate count of numbers testing this summer. Procedures for the day of the test:

Students should arrive at the TWHS senior campus no later than 7:30. They must have a photo id, such as a driver's license, school id, or passport, to test. They will check in at the grade level office on the second floor and told their testing room number at that time. Once a student is finished testing, he/she should exit the testing room and leave campus.

Parents may pick up and drop off in the front of the building. To locate the grade level office, students should enter the front door, turn left and follow the hallway to the cafeteria. Go up the stairs in the cafeteria and turn right. You will see the grade level office on the left.
